  3. Write the STUDENT # on a piece of paper and put it in the front pocket of the backpack. **This is crucial as it is the only way we will be able to match it up with the student at the event.**
  4. Drop it off at our office on the drop off date in August that will be listed on the sign up. Our office is located at 1298 7th Ave in the lower level of the Carnegie building - you may enter on the East side. If you are unable to get your backpack to their offices, you may leave them at the church, and I will see that they are delivered by the due date in early August.
