The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod is currently working with five partner churches to help refugees from this conflict. These church bodies are located in Latvia, Lithuania, Romania, Germany and the Czech Republic. In Ukraine, Rev. Serge Maschewski, bishop of the ELCU, requested funds for medicine; fuel for the evacuation of children, women and the elderly; food; and personal safety gear for pastors who work in dangerous areas. "Today we need food. Tomorrow we need medicine. The list changes daily," Maschewski said.
