After scene 13, join us in the victory celebration when Jesus rises from the dead. You will be ushered up to receive a white cross on your cheek representing that you are part of The Story as well. This of course, is optional. All are welcome.

Costumes

Characters in darker clothing are depicting demons, Pharisees, soldiers, and various roles that oppose the kingdom of God, with Satan being in all black. We simply call them “The Bads”.

Characters in colorful or white clothing are depicting members of Jesus’ life including His own disciples. Jesus is dressed in all white. We call this group of people “The Goods”.

Character in gray clothing This character represents everyday people in our modern world. We experience everyday things and also have a chance to experience the Gospel of Christ! We call this character “Our Guy”.

Character in black and white clothing This character depicts Judas who was a disciple and follower of Jesus prior to turning against him, betraying Jesus for selfish gain.

Scene 1 – Three Bad Things

Our Guy struggles with the difficulties of life in our world today. The only hope we have in this world is Jesus. He invites us to step into his story.

Scene 2 – Jesus’ Baptism

Matthew 3:13-17

John the Baptist prepared the way for Christ. People came from far and wide to receive the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit descended upon him and that same Spirit lives in us through our baptism.

River of Life – Mac Powell

Scene 3 - Gathering the Disciples

Matthew 4:18-22

Jesus invites us to “make fishers of men” and invite our neighbors to His Kingdom. Jesus chose 12 unlikely followers to be his disciples.

Don’t hang your head when you get lonely
I know I’ll never leave your side”*

Scene 4 – Miracles

John 2:1-11; Mark 5:35-42; Luke 17:11-19; John 9:1-7; John 8:1-11; Matthew 19:13-15;
Matthew 14:13-21

Jesus was fully man and fully God. He did extraordinary things during his earthly ministry. He turned water into wine, He healed the sick and lame, He fed the 5,000, He raised the dead, and He forgave the sinners.

Miracles – Colton Dixon

Scene 5 - Palm Sunday

Matthew 21:1-11

The people of Jerusalem were overjoyed to welcome Jesus. “Hosanna!” they sang.

Scene 6 - Gambling in the Temple/Judas' Betrayal

Matthew 21:12-13; Matthew 26:14-16

The holiest of places was used for unholy things. Jesus cleared the temple and reminded everyone that God's house is a holy place. Judas was tempted into the worst of sins. The betrayal of Jesus had begun...

Scene 7 - Last Supper

Matthew 26:14-29; Luke 22:14-34

Jesus and his followers gather for one final meal together. He tells them that one of them will betray him. Jesus welcomes us to the table today to share in this meal.

Scene 8 - Garden of Gethsemane

Matthew 26:36-46

While Jesus pleads with God about what will soon happen, the devil tempts Jesus’ disciples to fall asleep instead of praying. Jesus has faith that God has a plan.

Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth

Scene 9 - Jesus’ Arrest and Trial

Matthew 26:47-56; Matthew 27:11-26

Jesus was betrayed by Judas, beaten by men, and denied by his own disciples. Would you have had the courage to tell the world, “He’s Innocent!”?

Scene 11 - Mourning the Death of Jesus

Without Jesus, there is no hope. The disciples mourn Jesus' death for 3 days.
