After scene 15, join us in the victory celebration when Jesus rises from the dead. You will be ushered up to receive a white cross on your cheek representing that you are part of The Story as well. This of course, is optional. All are welcome.

Costumes

Characters in darker clothing are depicting Pharisees, soldiers, and various roles that oppose the kingdom of God, with Satan dressed in all black. We simply call them “The Bads”.

Characters in colorful or white clothing are depicting members of Jesus’ life including His own disciples. Jesus is dressed in all white. We call this group of people “The Goods”.

Character in gray clothing This character represents everyday people in our modern world. We experience everyday things and also have a chance to experience the Gospel of Christ! We call this character “Our Guy”.

Character in black and white clothing This character depicts Judas who was a disciple and follower of Jesus prior to turning against him, betraying Jesus for selfish gain.

Scene 4 – Jesus is Baptized

Scene 6 – Miracles

John 2:1-11, Luke 17:11-19, John 9:1-7, Matthew 19:13-15, Matthew 14:13-21

Jesus was fully man and fully God. He did extraordinary things during his earthly ministry. He turned water into wine, He healed the sick and lame, He fed the 5,000, He raised the dead, and He FORGIVES the sinner.

Scene 7 - Palm Sunday

Matthew 21:1-11

The people of Jerusalem were overjoyed to welcome Jesus. “Hosanna!” they sang.

Scene 8 - Gambling in the Temple/Judas' Betrayal

Matthew 21:12-13; Matthew 26:14-16

The holiest of places was used for unholy things. Jesus cleared the temple and reminded everyone that God's house is a holy place. Judas was tempted into the worst of sins. The betrayal of Jesus had begun...

Silence the World – Demon Hunter

Scene 9 - Last Supper

Matthew 26:14-29; Luke 22:14-34

Jesus and his followers gather for one final meal together. He tells them that one of them will betray him. Jesus welcomes us to the table today to share in this meal.

Scene 10 - Garden of Gethsemane

Matthew 26:36-46

While Jesus pleads with God about what will soon happen, the devil tempts Jesus' disciples to fall asleep instead of praying. Jesus has faith that God has a plan.

First Things First – Consumed by Fire

*“First thing's first, I seek Your will. Not my own.
Surrender all my wants to you.
Keep the first thing first.”*

Scene 11 - Jesus' Arrest and Trial / Peter Denies Jesus

Matthew 26:47-56; Matthew 26:69-75;

Matthew 27:11-26

Jesus was betrayed by Judas, beaten by men, and denied by his own disciples. Would you have had the courage to tell the world, “He's Innocent!”?

Crossfire - Skillet

Scene 12 - The Crucifixion of Jesus

Matthew 27:27-60

Jesus paid the ultimate price to give us freedom from the punishment of our sins. Because of His great sacrifice, we will be with Him forever in eternity.

God, You poured out Your life

Scene 13 – Our Guy: The Challenges Continue

Satan prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking to devour someone to devour. Our Guy continues to face challenges and although he suffers for a little while, he has faith that the Gospel journey continues.
