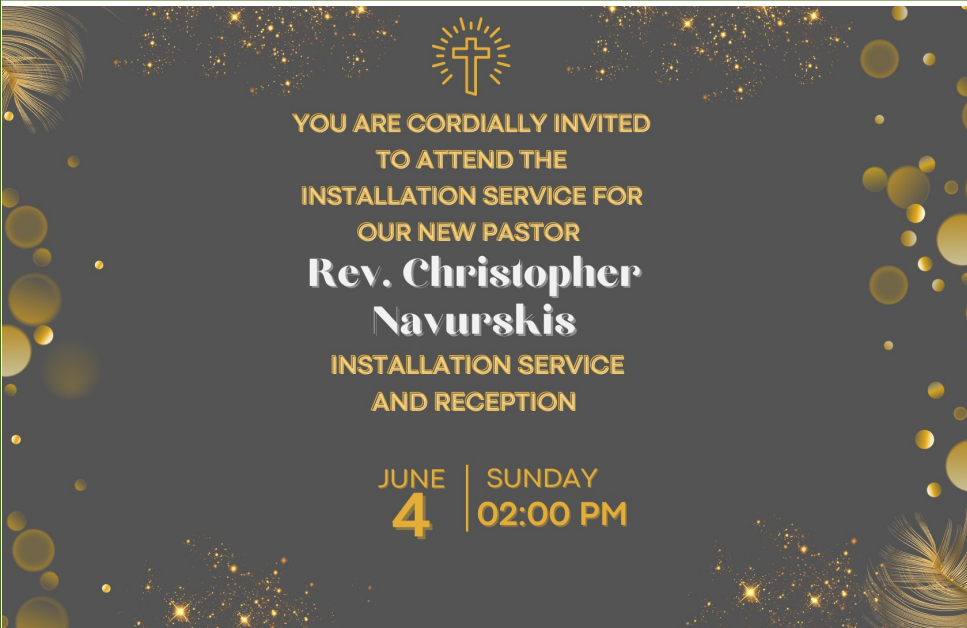
VBS Donation Board
